[Mama's] last week, however, was a miracle in so many quiet ways. We were able to bring her home for hospice care. We were able to have those last days to take care of her and watch her as she watched Heaven unfold before her eyes. She smiled at sights we could not see but yet she prepared us for her parting. She took the time to love us and hug us and tell us goodbye in her own special way. I was able to lay beside her and hold her hand for hours the day before she died and just absorb the miracle of being her daughter. And, yes, that was a miracle as well. Her last breaths as I held her hand and told her it was time to go home was also a miracle as she simply slipped away from living pink to Heavenly white. She was here and then she was home. All of those moments were miracles if we recognize what God allows us to behold when a saint beholds his face at last.
